

**Role: Evening**

**Car park: The Firs.**

### **General tips:**

- **You must wear a hi-viz vest during your shift.** When your shift is finished, please return your vest back to its storage box. Whenever you are not wearing a hi-viz vest (i.e. starting or finishing a shift) please keep to the marked pedestrian areas.
  - **All accompanied children must wear a hi-viz vest.** These will be available in a box marked 'kids hi-viz vests'
- Please familiarise yourself with the GP volunteer information pack which contains useful information. A copy will also be available for you on site.
  - Please be aware of the [exit routes from the car park](#) you are volunteering and the [traffic restrictions on the local roads](#) before arriving for your shift as you may be asked for advice by customers.
- Your main position will be around the main field entrance.
- Familiarise yourself with the location of the first aid kit and toilets.

### **Key role activities:**

- Be aware of pedestrians exiting / entering the car park – **pedestrians have priority** – all drivers should be advised to drive slowly and/or stop.
- Remind pedestrians to keep to pedestrian areas.
- Check all signs are secure and facing vehicle / pedestrian flow.
- Check fence posts are secure within the parking and pedestrian areas.
- Replace any broken barrier tape within the parking and pedestrian areas..
- Check pedestrian areas are clearly defined and signposted.
- Check for potholes / trip hazards (i.e. branches) in the field.
  - Fill any potholes with sand.
  - Remove trip hazards.

### **When you've finished:**

- Check plastic storage box marked 'The Firs Entrance / Evening' contents and place behind the brick wall by the main car park entrance for the morning or big tidy up teams to access.
- Inform the on-call director you have left site: 01327 221772.

### **Who to report to:**

- The on-call director will check in with you either by phone or in person around your start time.
- On call director: 01327 221772.

### **Where you'll find what we provide:**

- Plastic storage box marked 'Entrance / Evening' behind the brick wall by the main car park entrance.
- All other equipment will be behind the brick wall by the main car park entrance.

**Please ensure all items are returned to these locations for the morning or big tidy up teams!**

- Closed toe shoes
